



Reservations now required at all County campgrounds *No first-come, first-serve usage allowed*

Effective July 1, camping reservations are now required at Dos Reis Regional Park in Lathrop, Westgate Landing Regional Park in Lodi and Stillman Magee Regional Park in Clements. Same-day reservations may be accepted if available, and all reservations must be made through the Parks Administrative Office, located inside Micke Grove Regional Park in Lodi.

The new policy eliminates first-come, first-serve usage at the campgrounds, as well as the 21-day advance reservation requirement. **Reservations are only be accepted from 8 AM to 4:15 PM Monday through Friday and can be made either by credit card at (209) 953-8800 or in person at the Parks Administrative Office, 11793 N. Micke Grove Rd., Lodi. Due to COVID-19, there is a 10-day maximum stay at Dos Reis & Westgate Landing regional parks.**

Camping and day-use at Stillman Magee remain temporarily closed due to COVID-19. **Rafters floating down the Mokelumne River can still disembark at Stillman Magee, as the parking area is available for loading and unloading only. Parking fees still apply (\$5 weekends and \$6 weekends and most holidays, \$10 special holidays including July 4th) and is available 8 AM to 30 min before sunset.**

While the water play feature at Micke Grove Regional Park is open 11 AM to 5 PM daily, Woodbridge Wilderness Area is temporarily closed after reopening June 18. Guests are encouraged to check the parks' website or social media pages for a possible reopening date.

Playgrounds at all parks, along with Micke Grove Zoo, Fun Town, Oak Grove Nature Center, Regional Sports Complex and Harmony Grove Church, remain closed. Micke Grove and Oak Grove Regional Parks will continue to operate with modified hours of 8 AM to 6 PM daily. Day-use facilities at Dos Reis, Westgate Landing and Mossdale Crossing regional parks are open from 8 AM until 30 minutes before sunset. Micke Grove's Japanese Garden is open during its regular posted operating hours.

Social gatherings are still prohibited at all county parks. Any gatherings must remain within a single household and all first-come, first-serve rules apply, including no tables or chairs, bounce houses, amplified sound, water apparatuses, trailer BBQ's or generators. Park closures may be reinstated if social distancing protocols are not followed.

Guests are advised to remain home if sick or unwell and practice social distancing to prevent COVID-19.
